

**CARBON-MONROE-PIKE MH/DS  
MENTAL HEALTH STATUS REPORT  
January 2023**

**STAFFING:**

The MH Department currently has eight openings: 4 FCM, 3 TCM and 1 Director of Consumer Supports position.

**BUDGET:**

We are receiving level funding for FY 22/23.

**GENERAL:**

- Carbon and Monroe Counties were not selected to do a Sequential Intercept Mapping Workshop
- CMP, Wayne, Lackawanna, and Susquehanna will be receiving grant funding to develop a community based walk in crisis center.

**DEPARTMENTS/PROJECTS:**

- **Administrative Case Management:**  
ACM Department completed 9 intakes, 165 screening calls and served 482 consumers in total in December 2022.
- **Targeted Case Management:**  
TCM Department received 34 referrals, completed 10 intakes, 8 discharges, and served 341 individuals in December 2022. TCM services are now for referrals in Monroe, however they remain closed in Carbon and Pike Counties, due to staff vacancies.
- **Forensic Department:**  
The FCM Department completed 6 intakes in December, 0 discharges, had 0 individuals released from facilities and worked with 99 individuals in total. There are currently 6 CMP residents in Norristown Regional Forensic Center. We have 2 individuals on a wait list for Norristown. We are working with 1 individual involved in Carbon Veterans Treatment Court and 33 individuals involved in Carbon Drug Treatment Court.
- **CASSP:**  
There are 8 youth in Community Residential Rehabilitation placements and 36 in Residential Treatment Facilities. There was 2 discharges and 3 recommendations for out of home placement. 9 SAP (Student Assistance Program) Assessments were completed in December. This department has 66 individuals on their caseloads in December 2022.
- **CHIPP:**  
There are currently 11 individuals in Clarks Summit State Hospital (CSSH). There was 0 admissions, 1 diversion, and 0 individuals on the wait list. 2 individuals are ready for discharge however they are waiting for skilled facility placement. We have 2 individuals in our community based Extended Acute Care program; 0 admissions and we have 1 individual on the wait list and 0 were diverted to a lower level of care. 66 individuals were served by CHIPP in December 2022.
